

**To host a Crossroads Emmaus gathering, your church will be asked to provide:**

- A meeting place for 75 to 100 people.
- Paper goods and plastic ware for the meal (plates, cups, napkins, knives, forks, and spoons).
- Drinks (tea, coffee, and water).
- Worship area.
- Communion elements (bread and juice).
- We would love to involve your clergy in the worship service. If your clergy has not been on a Walk to Emmaus weekend, our clergy is available to assist with the worship service.
- If your church has a music team, we would love to utilize them for the gathering. Please let us know at the time of scheduling if your music team will provide music for the gathering.
- A person from your church or community to deliver the fourth day talk. Fourth day talks should be between 5 and 15 minutes in length and address the following questions:
  - (1) What has the Walk to Emmaus meant to me?
  - (2) What have you done about it?
